#### **Planning Phase**

IHPBA outreach in Kathmandu, Nepal was conducted first in 2014 under the leadership of Dr P Jagannath. Then in 2017, second outreach was conducted in Kathmandu followed by establishment of the IHPBA Nepal chapter. We had our third outreach in 2019 in Kathmandu focused in Pancreaticobiliary Surgery under the leadership of Prof Ajith Siriwardane. We progressed from general HPB diseases to focused pancreaticobiliary diseases.

After Covid-19, the outreach was expanded outside Kathmandu valley in 2021 under the leadership of Prof Thomas van Gulik where outreach was conducted in Chitwan as well as in Kathmandu. Then in 2022, besides Chitwan, outreach was conducted in Pokhara as well focussing mainly in "Safe Cholecystectomy". In 2023, under the leadership of Prof Thomas van Gulik, outreach was conducted in the western region of Nepal, Nepalgunj, including Pokhara, Baglung and Kathmandu. In Kathmandu, more complicated HPB diseases were discussed while "Safe cholecystectomy" in Nepalgunj and other benign HPB diseases like hydatid cyst, pancreatitis were discussed in Pokhara and Baglung.

It is through IHPBA Nepal chapter with TUTH in Kathmandu as central hub, that educational activities are continued in hospitals remote from Kathmandu, where HPB services need to be improved. The local team will take care of this program independent of support by the IHPBA Foundation.

This year we intend to visit Dhangadi, which is in far western Nepal. We will have a health camp where we will have a clinic to see patients. Then we will have an interactive session with the local surgeons led by Dr Chandra Prakash Pandey on benign HPB diseases like Hydatid cyst, Acute pancreatitis, Chronic pancreatitis which are common in that part of Nepal.

## **Details of Delivery Phase**

We had one day program on benign HPB diseases with didactic lecture including videos with very interactive sessions with the local organizing body comprising of Society of Surgeons Nepal, Province 7, Far west branch. The one day course was attended by the local surgeons and few residents from Kathmandu with total of 50 participants. The program is attached below:

#### **Use of Funding**

Total expenditure=1,99,000/ (equivalent to USD 1485)

### Assessment of Impact

The local surgeons were introduced to IHPBA. This one-day program on benign HPB diseases generated interest in HPB surgery and the drive to get good out and to strive for excellence in HPB surgery, patient care and research. The local surgeons have been asked to do the audit of the cases done after the In-Reach program to evaluate the impact of In-Reach in the clinical practice. One of the representatives will present the audit in next In-Reach/Outreach program in another part of Nepal.
